Operator/Manager's Report: February 2021; 3-4-21

2-1-21 Water Sample at Licht Residence.

2-14-21 Dwight had a lot of problems with the #2 pump. It was hard to prime, but once primed in it ran fairly well. Dwight wonders if the sand needs replacing because we are going thru filters every 7 days. 2-15-21 I started back washing with the #3 pump. I talked to Mike Moeller with SD Rural Water in Spearfish. We discussed the short filter life we are having. I described the situation and he felt the Sand filters were working. I asked if switching from Alum to a Polimar might help. He said he thought it would, and suggested that I contact Derick Alexander at Hawkins Chemical.

I contacted Derick and he said there was a Polimar that would be much better than Alum as a coagulating agent. He said it is much more expensive, but you use less of it because it is more efficient. Next month he will come out and do a Jar Test to see which Polimar will work the best. He said Alum does not work well with cold water. (Historically our shortest filter life is in the winter when the water is the coldest) if we switch to a Polimar we need to go thru the approval process with DENR. I called Jim Zek the head guy for SD Rural Water in Madison. I explained our situation. He thinks the sand filters are working OK but feels that they are not getting completely clean. He suggested that I go from a 4-minute back wash cycle to a 6-minute backwash cycle for 2 weeks to see if there is any difference. The years of high creek flow over time probably led to the filters gradually getting overloaded. He also said that Alum does not work well in cold water. Years ago, Jack had short filter life. He changed the sand thinking that was the problem. New sand did not help.

I have been using a 6-minute back wash cycle for over 2 weeks now and the last night I changed filters and got 14 days and 365,296 gallons of water. That is the best filter life since 1-4-21. There have been 5 filter changed between 1-4-21 & today 3-3-21 that have been averaging 7 days.

2-16-21 strong chlorine smell. Could not find a cause

2-17-21 2 burp line check valves were leaking. I cleaned them & they are working fine now.

2-18-21 reservoir reading 1.1' (full is 8') Pump was on. I checked the reservoir and found it to be over full and just about ready to overflow. Snow covering solar panel caused the battery to run down. Also, the light bulb on the thermo cube in the control box was burned out. Installed a new bulb and cleared the snow off the solar panel. Also freed the reservoir float that was frozen at 6'. (I have never seen that happen in over 20 years.)

2-23-21 I got my 1st Covid Shot

All in all, February went fairly well.

Dwight worked 8 days in February.

We pumped 736,142 gallons
