5-7-24 New Filters PM, 12 days, 443,520 gallons

5-18-24 Mike changed filters, 11 days, 391,276 gallons

5-19-24 5:28 AM got calls of low pressure in Rolling Hills. Found Carter Reservoir about empty.

Turned intake valve to full on. I had checked the reservoir Friday and everything was fine.

Extraordinary water use drained the reservoir in a day and a half. Reservoir was full by 5:00 PM but several low pressure area customers had air locks in their lines. Al Sage came out and helped get water to one customer. He also looked at the reservoir and said he could install a new float valve and repair the reservoir hatches. We will need to drain the reservoir for the repair and he can clean and inspect the reservoir at the same time. I told him to go ahead and schedule it. Everyone had water by mid day on Monday. I discovered a way to temporally boost pressure to get air out of the lines. This will be very helpful as this could happen again the future. I am back to checking reservoir levels twice a day.

5-22-24 Raked and seeded dig areas at Rowley Residence and corner of Heritage & Pioneer.

5-24-24 Hauled 4.2 yards of top soil to Heritage Lane dig area. Richard Smith helped with the raking and I seeded the dig area on the east dig area.

5-25-24 Hauled another 19 cu ft of top soil to west dig area and again Richard Smith helped with the prep. I seeded the area.

5-31-24 New filters PM, 14 days, 577,611 gallons

Dwight worked 4 ½ days in May, Mike worked 8 days.

We pumped 1,208,442 gallons in May

Scot proposed that we order a spare pump Craig made motion John seconded. The new pump would be to be available to replace #2. Motion passed unanimously
